Summary of the Lesson: Students will learn about the history of books, learn how to cut, measure and fold pages for the book, and create their own accordion book, Students will also have the option to add color to the pages.		
Vocabulary: Math: Inches Parallel lines Art Deckled edge Fold signature		Materials: Paper Ruler Scissors Glue stick Watercolor, colored pencil markers (optional)

ARTS LESSON STRUCTURE: Attention, Review, Teach, and Support

ATTENTION How will you prepare the students for the lesson?

I will go over the history of books, Show examples and demonstrate how to measure, cut and fold papers and glue pages to execute the accordion book structure.

REVIEW: What will you review? What is the academic vocabulary for the lesson?

I will review how to properly use a ruler, cut and fold signatures and glue them together to produce the desired effect.

TEACH: What will you do to teach the content?

I will show a Powerpoint presentation that includes history of bookmaking and also demonstrate how to create this unique book.

Support: What will you assign the students to complete and how will you support their learning?

Students will create an accordion book of their own from start to completion. I will also demonstrate options for adding color and interest to the book pages as well as ideas on how to use their books for maximum enjoyment.
