




Important Note: We will need 2 of these so draw one and trace the design on another paper to get a <u>copy!</u>

outline that represents YOU. Think of the "Rule of Thirds"! *First third is the head *Second third is the torso *Third third is the legs and feet

Begin by drawing an



Next cut out the hair, clothing, shoes, and anything else you want your Selfie Doll to hold! Have Fun with this part and Make it YOU!



Glue the hair, clothes, shoes and any accessories to the Selfie Doll form

Next begin to draw in the face, any details on clothing and shoes and accessories

Amazing so far! Next we will glue the front and back of the Selfie Doll Together, but first we must prepare the stuffing!



Ríp small pieces of paper to fill the inside of your doll. Only ríp what you will need! *Put the front and back of your doll together

*Carefully add your "stuffing"

* Slowly and with great care glue around the perimeter of all your edges, making sure that all edges are glued shut.
