Summary of the Lesson:			

Students were introduced to tapestry weaving through a Power Point presentation and video of weavers working on a monumental tapestry weaving. Students will use their rulers to measure out a mini cardboard loom, create tabs to hold the warp strings and learn to weave the weft strings to create colorful one of a kind woven designs. Students will also learn to use their ruler as a shed stick and a pen as a tapestry needle! A great lesson in sustainability also!

In this lesson students learned to use their rulers and measure the loom and tabs to hold their warp strings.
