Core Content Learning Objective: -to learn about clay -think of an object with which they identify -write paragraph about why they chose object to create out of clay – the 'meaning' behind their object		-paragraph written b	Assessment: -if students created an object out of clay -paragraph written by students about object selection – what does their object mean to them?	
Arts Learning Objective: -learn 3 basic clay hand-building techniques -to think in 3-D -love the feel of clay			Assessment: -did students successfully create their object in clay -did students use one of basic hand-building techniques	
Summary of the Lesson:
