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ARTS LESSON STRUCTURE: Attention, Review, Teach, and Support

Attention: How will you prepare the students for the lesson?

Teach: What will you do to teach the content?

Share examples of villains and sidekicks from famous comic book stories and trends in storytelling - formerly marginalized characters becoming the central characters of their own stories.

E.g. Echo aka Maya Lopez of Hawkeye and Daredevil comic stories, Falcon (Captain America), Teen Titans, Harley Quinn, Loki, Wanda Maximoff, Kamala Khan aka Ms. Marvel

Also - mirror image villain version of hero characters and superpets.

Support: What will you assign the students to complete and how will you support their learning?

Students will imagine either a sidekick or a villain as an additional character in their stories in progress.

Closure: What will we do to reinforce learning and close the lesson for today?

Students will draw a picture of their new character and write a caption describing who the character is and what dangerous powers or helpful abilities they offer.
