Will go over Public art emphasizing scale and proportion. Show the importance of having a study or a plan before doing a Final project. Study will show how to make a whole into halves and then quarters. And to allow students to make the spider 'their own' by finishing the final details in color in a way that shows Their individuality and creativity. ARTS LESSON STRUCTURE: Attention, Review, Teach and Support Attention: How will you prepare the students for the lesson? Artist Go over works of Louise B and show show where there is overlapping with the previous Projects. Have the kids think about what sculptures they have seen in their 'every day Life' and show examples of other public art. Have students do a study of spider which will go over halves, and quarters, symmetry and have then Use their brown and black watercolors which they haven't used yet. Have experiential practice in then dividing clay into halves, quarters and ultimately eighths To make head and eight legs of spider to make their own spider which they will finish having artistic Licence to use their art kits to finish - Watercolors, markers (which do work on the finished Clay ) and potentially using glue stick to add a sort of collage on top of color if time permits. **TEACHER**
