Core Content Learning Objective: Complete writing of stories onto back of panels.	Assessment: Ability to share story with a partner.	
Arts Learning Objective: Completion of full story.	Assessment: Share story panels with a partner, and with class.	
Summary of the Lesson: Students are warmed up with a movement activity. The artist reviews active listening. Students are given some quiet writing time to complete their stories. The artist shows how to rearrange the panels to create new story structures. Students swap stories with each other. At the end of class, a few share their work with the class.
