ARTS LESSON STRUCTURE: Attention, Review, Teach, and Support

Attention: How will you prepare the students for the lesson?			
Teacher Students are asked to determine story structure elements of the story we read, so they should have a strong background for identifying characters and traits.	Artist I'll ask the students to share what they already know about story elements and character. I'll ask them to share some of their favorite characters and why. I'll talk about my own process of using people/characters in my own creative work.		
Review: What will you review? What is the academic vocabulary for the lesson?			
Teacher The academic vocabulary for this lesson will be characters, character traits, and character sketches.	Artist We will quickly review what we discussed and the work we started in Session 3.

Teach: What will you do to teach the content?

Teacher

Characters and character traits will be taught as we read stories, novels, poems, and watch videos. Characters' actions, thoughts, feelings, etc. will be discussed in order to develop and understand different traits of different characters. Students will do a journal entry describing their own traits.

Artist

Session 4 will mostly be creating/writing time for the students.

While they write, I'll be available on camera to answer student questions or give additional directions, if needed.

Support: What will you assign the students to complete and how will you support their learning?

Teacher

Students will create their own character sketch of themselves or a character from a story, whichever they choose.

Artist

The students will be given time to complete their I AM poem and create titles for their poems. As they do, I'll be available on camera and to answer questions and give encouragement.

Closure: What will we do to reinforce learning and close the lesson for today?

We'll provide time for the students to read their poems in a whole-group setting and share something they learned. We'll watch a video of Nikki Giovanni reading her poem, "Quilts." I'll offer extension exercises as well to finish Lesson 3.
