Core Content Learning Objective: Write the introduction of a story Use of the five senses	Assessment: Ability to use five senses in writing an introduction.	
Arts Learning Objective: Get started on writing the story they have worked on visually.	Assessment: Share start of writing.	
Summary of the Lesson: Students are warmed up with a focus warm up.. A video about story introductions and figurative language is shared. A student shares their story map, and the introduction is discussed. An example is shared, and students are given a review of writing with the five senses in mind. Some quiet writing time is given to start their stories, and then some are shared.

Support: What will you assign the students to complete and how will you support their learning?	
Closure: What will we do to reinforce learning and close the lesson for today?
