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Summary of the Lesson:

Students are warmed up with a sentence writing activity. The artist shares the vocabulary of rough draft. An example is shared of writing the parts of a story with detailed description, and students are given some quiet writing time to continue their stories. At the end of class, a few share their work so far.
