











VOCABULARY





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Pointillism

the practice of applying small strokes or dots of color to a surface so that from a distance they visually blend together

Repetition

the use of the same visual effect a number of times in the same composition






WHAT IS POINTILLISM?

(1 + 2 = 3)
























- What two colors make up that background color? What needs to get added together?
- Use those two colors to make dots next to each other.
- Notice that if you step back, your eyes add the colors together and they blend.
