ARTS LESSON STRUCTURE: Attention, Review, Teach, and Support

Teacher	Artist
-Look at different currencies from different countries	-review of materials needed for lesson -brief discussion of why humans invented money -the idea that the students will be asked to design and create their own currency
<u>Review:</u> What will you review? What is the academic vo	ocabulary for the lesson?
Teacher	Artist -money -currency -barter -'cowrie shell' -portable -denomination





Teach: What will you do to teach the content? Teacher Artist -Looked at different currencies -brief history of currency - (why humans needed it, the earliest forms of currency, what are the necessary attributes of money) -presentation of currency, with examples of currencies around the world -examples of paper currency created by students Support: What will you assign the students to complete and how will you support their learning? Artist Teacher -Kids took it over – they created their own currencies; -students were challenged to sketch, design and create they traded their monies with each other one piece of paper currency -students challenged to include on their currency: an image (for their theme), a denomination and a motto -students asked to write what would they buy with their currency – and why

Closure: What will we do to reinforce learning and close the lesson for today?
