| Summary of the Lesson: Students are warmed up with a movement activity. The artist reviews the rough draft. An example is shared of writing the parts of a story with detailed description, and students are given some quiet writing time to continue their stories. At the end of class, a few share their work so far. | | |

Attention: How will you prepare the students for the lesson?

Have prepared materials for students

Review parts of story

Assist with discussions.

Artist

Conduct warm up.

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Teach: What will you do to teach the content?

Reinforce vocabulary.

Connect to knowledge already learned.

Assist with work as needed.

Artist

Review and discuss vocabulary.

Review use of the five senses in writing.

Model how to write parts of the story.

Model ordering of panels.

Support: What will you assign the students to complete and how will you support their learning?

Closure: What will we do to reinforce learning and close the lesson for today?
